Join us for a day to remember with Deltic 'Royal Scots Grey' and Pathfinder Railtours as we take you on a journey from Didcot, Oxford and the Midlands to the historic medieval city of York. After the last pick up station at Tame Bridge, the train will travel via Crewe to Warrington and then onto Manchester. From here over the Trans-Pennine route where 22 and other Deltics worked during the final years with B.R. We will pass through Huddersfield and Leeds before arriving at our destination of York, where you will be able to attend the huge Railfest at the National Railway Museum.

This event will host some of the very best of British railway engineering featuring the world's fastest steam locomotive 'Mallard', the newly built A1 'Tornado' and fellow Deltic 55 002 'The King's Own Yorkshire Light Infantry' as well as many other locomotives and other attractions. York is home to some of the finest pubs, traditional restaurants and top quality shops, all within the historic city walls.

On the return journey, 'Royal Scots Grey' will haul the train over the Classes old stomping ground of the East Coast Main Line, veering off just before Kings Cross station, to head for the Great Western Main Line via Reading to Didcot and the setting down stations back to the Midlands to complete this great summer's day out.
